Note from the Senior Pastor

This January, we hope the greatest number of you, since I have been here, will sign on to read through the entire Word with us. Let me know if you are beginning, or beginning again, to read through the Word of God. I also encourage those on their way through the Chronological Bible this time around. Becky and I are really enjoying another year to peruse through the daily reading of the Old and New Testament.

This all brings me great joy, but I was thinking the other day, what would be better is making sure the Word is getting into me, us! The scriptures tell us the Word is to be hidden in us to give us the ability to not sin against God. Psalm 119:11 **“Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.”** Yet Jesus said of the Pharisee’s in John 5:39-40 **“You study the Scriptures diligently because you think that in them you have eternal life. These are the very Scriptures that testify about me, yet you refuse to come to me to have life.”** Jesus draws a distinction between being in the word and it being in us. That dissimilarity is one of eternal life consequences.

Allow me to further challenge us in this still New Year: to make sure we are doing more than getting into the word, but rather, as in the saying of our Lord Jesus, making sure the word dwells in us by believing in the one it tells of, and coming to follow his teachings and example. In other words, be doers of the word and not mere hearer, or “readers” of it!

The Bible is so much more than the greatest self-help book, with little adages of how to live better and happier in our conscious. The scriptures reveal; God saying to Abraham “Now I know you love me, because you did not withhold your son, your only son whom you love, from me.” It is from internalizing a passage like this that gives us the confidence to say to any skeptic: “Now we know God loves us because we do not withhold from Him.” Let’s continue to do the Word in 2019 and let’s continue to do it together here in the Church at Braddock!

Well, let’s all stay in the Word this year, and seek earnestly to be obedient to its illuminations.
