Note from the Associate Pastor

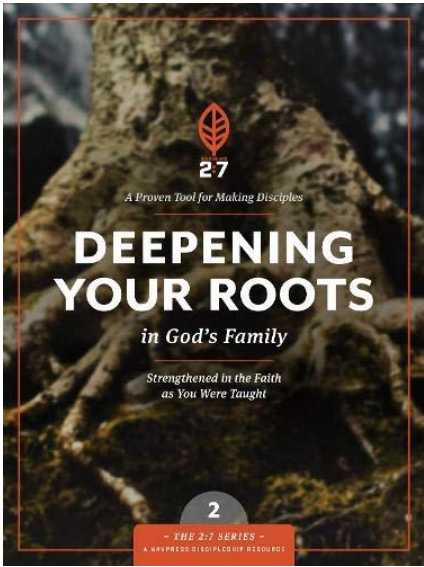
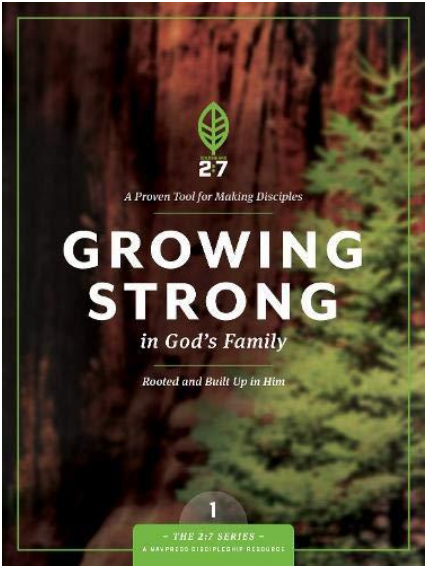
Beloved members of BBC Family,
