

Pastor's Corder Note

This month always rings in "Independence Day". On July 4, 1776, the thirteen colonies claimed their independence from England, an event which eventually led to the formation of the United States. Each year on July 4th, also known as Independence Day, Americans celebrate this historic event.

Conflict between the colonies and England was already a year old when the colonies convened a Continental Congress in Philadelphia in the summer of 1776. July 4 has been designated a national holiday to commemorate the day the United States laid down its claim to be a free an independent nation. (Military.com-Independence Day)

For Christians/Christ followers, or Holy Spirit led believers, there is another independence day! As with most, if not all, freedoms, comes responsibility, accountabilities or duties. Independence Day in the Spirit:

2 Corinthians 3:17 ¹⁷ **Now** the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. ¹⁸ And we all, who with unveiled faces contemplate the <u>Lord's glory</u>, are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the

Lord, who is the Spirit.

With the declaration of independence, proclaiming of freedom for the colonies from the rule and taxation of Great Britten, battles ensued. For freedom did not come to this nation without a great cost! Nor does the freedom in the Spirit come without a great cost and a continual allegiance is required.

2 Corinthians 10:4-6 ⁴ The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. ⁵ We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ. ⁶ And we will be ready to punish every act of disobedience, once your obedience is complete.

For me spiritual Independence Day came August 11, 1974. And that very day I was liberated, for whom the Son has set free is free indeed! Since that day I have walked in freedom from many of the shackles that had bound me, while walking in my sin nature, but as the scripture above indicates that some of the things I have been set free of, I now under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit can't even allow myself to think about! The same Holy Spirit who empowers us to overcome sin, instructs us to not even "think about it"!

We have the tendency to go in the direction we face, if you have ever been driving your car or riding on a bike and started looking off to the right or left you quickly found yourself going in that direction. If you, my reader, claim to be "Christian" (this term is Little Christ),- meaning you are attempting and are viewed by others as 'Christ Like"! Another term commonly used today is "Christ Follower". This indicates you are in step with and going in the direction He (Christ) is leading! Unlike the world the spirit realm is so far advanced from the natural, the Law that is for all mankind, points out don't commit adultery, humanity will be broken if this is not observed. Man pitted against man, but in the Spirit realm "don't even visualize (fantasize) it in your thoughts". For this too will break you in the victory you have been given over you sin!

Let's continue to celebrate and walk in our independence that is totally dependent upon the Spirit's enabling us and our obedience to the Lord who is the Spirit.





Crossing the Tagus River at Alcántara in Spain, the Alcántara Bridge is a masterpiece of ancient Roman bridge building. The bridge was built between 104 and 106 by an order of the Roman Emperor Trajan in 98 AD, who is honored by a triumphal arch in the center of the bridge and a small temple at one end. The Alcántara Bridge has taken more damage from war than from the elements. The Moors destroyed the smallest arch on one side while the second arch on the other side was destroyed by the Spanish to stop the Portuguese. Via Touropia
