

Due to vacations, we are catching you up this month on the Board meetings that occurred in June and July 2017.

In June, the following items were discussed:

- Summer Church Picnic logistics
- Specially called Business Meetings Agenda (see Business Meeting minutes in church office)
- Reviewed and Approved an Accountability Reimbursement Policy
- SOPs will need to be returned to Chairs for a review

In July, the following items were discussed:

- Approved Property Committee recommendation to fix the ‘dip’ in the sewer that caused a back up
- Drafted an appreciation letter to be sent to Dave Waters
- Discussed a letter from ABBCS noting that the school would like to stay at BBC
- Approved the Associate pastor and Ministry Volunteer Position Descriptions
- Started discussion of the SOP for the Board
- Approved that disbursements from the Wicker Williams fund (which is for the purpose of Missions) over \$500 must be approved by the Board. Amounts \$500 or less may be approved by the Senior Pastor.

Known as the Roman Bridge of Cangas de Onís, the “Puente Vieyu” or “Puentón”, this is one of the best-known symbols of the Principality of Asturias [Spain].

Although this site may have been used in Roman times to cross the Sella River, and this may have been the reason for the foundation of Cangas de Onís, the first capital of the Kingdom of Asturias, in fact the current “Roman Bridge” dates to medieval times, possibly to the end of the 13th century. It has three slightly pointed arches.. From the central arch hangs a reproduction of the famous Victory Cross, a work of precious metal dating to the start of the 10th century that is kept in Oviedo Cathedral.
